

**INFORMATION TO BE COMMUNICATED TO THE PUBLIC CONCERNING OPERATIONAL SAFETY  
MEASURES AND BEHAVIOUR IN THE EVENT OF AN ACCIDENT**

**PART 1**

For all establishments covered by Law 59/2016:

**1. Business owner name and site address:**

**2. Confirmation that the site is subject to the regulations and/or administrative provisions implementing Law 59/2016 and that the Notification referred to in Article 7 and in the Major Accident Prevention Policy set out in Article 8 para. (1) or in the Security Report referred to in Article 10 para. (1) have been submitted to the competent authority.**

Following the notice received from the Risk Office of the Environmental Protection Agency, S.C. Oscar Downstream SRL - the Roman working point is a lower-level site due to the presence on the site of hazardous substances in quantities higher than the relevant ones, as provided by Law no.59/2016.

Pursuant to the legal provisions, the following documents have been prepared/updated and submitted with the Risk Office of the Roman Environmental Protection Agency and Roman ISUJ:

Notification of activity registered with the SRAPM under no. 10402/20.12.2021.

Policy for the Prevention of Major Accidents Involving Hazardous Substances registered with the SRAPM under the no. 7464/31.08.2021;

**3. Explanation in simple terms of the activity or activities carried out at the establishment**

**According to the Confirmation of Company Details, - SC OSCAR DOWNSTREAM SRL - Roman "Fuel depot" working point in Roman, 5 Tirului Street, Neamt County, performs the following activities:**

- Main activity  
**4671: Wholesale of solid, liquid and gaseous fuels and related products**
- Other related activities  
**5210: Warehousing and storage**  
**5224: Handling**  
**4941; Freight transport by road.**

The operator is classified as a SEVESO objective because:

- they own a fuel depot, NACE Code CL007/SPIRS, where hazardous substances are stored and handled within the main activity, i.e. **Wholesale of solid, liquid and gaseous fuels and related products and related activities.**

4. The common names or, in the case of hazardous substances covered by Part 1 of Law 59/2016, the generic names or general hazard category of the substances and mixtures involved in the establishment which could lead to a major accident, indicating their main dangerous characteristics.

5. General information on how to warn the public concerned, if necessary; appropriate information on what to do in the event of a major accident or where this information may be accessed electronically.

In the event of a major accident (e.g. fire, explosion, toxic spillage, etc.) The Fuel Depot is equipped for public warning with automatic electric sirens. These devices are AUTOMATICALLY activated from within the site, or are activated by the personnel appointed/designated to perform certain drills and checks for such situations.

***In this regard, MAKE SURE:***

The warehouse is equipped with acoustic signaling to warn of an accident.

Communication, including the public information of the inhabitants with regards the areas potentially affected is also performed by telephone by the company's personnel appointed for this task

- ❖ The warehouse is equipped with acoustic signaling to warn of an accident.
- ❖ Communication, including the public information of the inhabitants with regards the areas potentially affected is also performed by telephone by the company's personnel appointed for this task.

- ❖ Any information and messages sent via the RO-ALERT system or via the authorities Warning messages transmitted by telephone, radio.

In addition, the operator must notify the competent authorities responsible for the application of Law 59/2016 (the Roman County Inspectorate for Emergency Situations, the Roman Environmental Protection Agency, the Roman County Commissioner of the Environmental Police, the public institutions responsible for the external emergency plan and the neighboring economic operators.

To avoid injury/poisoning, persons located in the risk area must observe the following guidelines:







**a) in case of major releases (toxic dispersions):**

- ✓ Move away from the accident site;
- ✓ Do not stand outdoors in order to avoid inhalation of toxic substance;
- ✓ Immediately take cover inside a building;
- ✓ Immediately close the windows and doors;
- ✓ If necessary, help the children, people with disabilities and the elderly;
- ✓ Disconnect air conditioners or fans in your area or car;
- ✓ Cover your nose and mouth with a wet handkerchief;
- ✓ In case of subsequently occurring health issues, seek medical help

**b) in case of fire or explosion:**

- ✓ Move away from the accident site;
- ✓ Do not stand in the direction of the air currents carrying combustion products. If necessary, protect your airways by covering your nose and mouth with a wet handkerchief and immediately move away from the area;
- ✓ Leave the building you are in if it is affected by the incident. If you can stay inside the building, disconnect air conditioners or fans in your area;
- ✓ If necessary, help the children, people with disabilities and the elderly.

**Life-saving reflexes**

 Enter a building	 Seal all air inlets	 Listen to the radio stations for instructions to follow
 Do not go to school to pick up your children, the school will take care of them	 The use of flames and smoking are prohibited	 Do not use the phone: leave the lines idle for the response teams

**6.
